Arena district reviews mixed

Condo, office towers could exceed local market needs

An ambitious plan to build office, hotel and condo towers alongside a downtown arena is getting mixed reviews from local real estate and development insiders.

If a new arena is approved, the Katz Group and partner WAM Development Group hope to push ahead this spring with \$2-billion worth of nearby development, including 28and 32-storey office towers.

Plans also include two 35-storey or taller condominium highrises, a 10-storey condo building, a 26-storey luxury hotel and other commercial space along with a proposed open-air Oilers Plaza.
